



# Curriculum

## AERO

NIS follows the American Education Reaches Out (AERO) COMMON CORE Plus curriculum for overseas schools. AERO provides a framework for curriculum consistency across grades K-12, in alignment with research-based trends and ongoing developments within this curriculum worldwide and in the USA.

## We are a NEASC accredited international school

NEASC works with schools to establish and maintain high standards for all levels of education. Colleges and employers look more favorably upon students who have come from a NEASC accredited school. NIS is one of only a few international schools in Dubai to be awarded the NEASC accreditation.

## We are member of National Honor Society

Internationally recognized National Honor Society (NHS) membership is an invitation-only honor that recognizes outstanding students' academic accomplishments and their community engagement. More than one million students participate in The National Honor Society (NHS) activities in all 50 USA states, Canada and throughout the world.



## We received the highest possible rating from the KHDA in the Distance Learning Evaluation

In the short amount of time since the International Schools Partnership acquired NIS Dubai, we've seen some remarkable improvements, demonstrable in the most recent KHDA inspection.

**NIS was rated 'Good' or 'Very Good' by the KHDA across 53 of the areas that used to be 'Acceptable' over the last two years.** There has been an immense amount of positive change including the improvement of facilities, resources, and to the teaching and learning at the school. This has all been done with the support of the leadership team at NIS, and the International Schools Partnership Regional team.

Below is a summary of the KHDA inspection findings and areas that were rated 'Good'.

- **Leadership and Management:** The Senior Leadership Team has achieved so much in the relatively short time since the last inspection. The majority of aspects across leadership, management, self-evaluation and improvement planning are now effective.
- **Students' Achievement:** Good progress has been made across all year groups. Students' personal and social skills remain at a good level, and attendance is good. Their attitude towards learning, towards others and towards the wider community are positive, particularly in high school.
- **Teaching and Assessment:** The quality of the curriculum has improved and it is now good across all phases. The range of courses available is extensive in the middle and high schools. There have been some innovative curriculum changes in both the KG and the elementary school.
- **Student Support:** Staff has actively addressed recommendations from the previous inspection. The school promotes health and well-being in a range of ways.experts with high expectations, guiding students to become confident, ambitious learners and leaders.



# Curriculum

## Our teachers are highly experienced and passionate about education

The foundation at NIS rests on quality teachers, dedicated to providing an exceptional education for every child. Our teachers are subject matter experts with high expectations, guiding students to become confident, ambitious learners and leaders.

## Our early years department provides an inspiring start

By balancing learning of the basics with inquiry-based learning, we apply the best of early years research to ensure the best start for our youngest children. Our innovative approach to early childhood education values the child as strong, capable and resilient, rich with wonder and knowledge.

## Arabic & Islamic Studies

Learning Arabic is crucial for both cognitive development and the maintenance of cultural identity. Our Arabic curriculum is concept and inquiry-based, and is in line with the UAE national curriculum. Arabic is compulsory for Arab nationals, and Arabic as a foreign language is mandatory for students through to Grade 9. It is compulsory for all Muslim students to study Islamic Studies. The NIS framework provides the highest possible standard of Islamic education.

## Unique opportunities for Middle and High School

Our NIS curriculum challenges students at high levels to prepare them for the College Board Advanced Placement (AP) program. Our students also participate in enrichment activities such as Student Council, the Global Future Leaders Conference and the Model United Nations (MUN).

## International Learning Opportunities

NIS provides a wide range of extra-curricular activities to help students cultivate individual interests, talents and develop their social skills. International enrichment trips offer your child the opportunity to explore a diversity of cultures and develop cultural sensitivity and awareness.

# Kindergarten

## KG English and Math Program

We specialize in providing a highly effective program to develop children's early English and mathematical skills. Our 'Letters and Sounds' phonics and strong literacy programs, ensure every child benefits from individualized learning of sounds, which then improves their reading fluency and understanding of language. Our everyday story time, guided reading and writing programs trigger children's imagination and nurture a love of reading. All our children experience early success in reading, writing and spelling.

Our math program is supported by various types of hands-on resources including Numicon. Numicon is a multi-sensory approach enhancing children's achievement across all mathematics ability levels.

## KG Facilities

Each classroom has dedicated centers covering the key areas of early development, whilst drawing on the children's interests. Teachers encourage children's active engagement through an inquiry-based approach designed to promote dialogue and thinking. Our learning areas offer a creative and supportive environment in which young children play and learn together. Our outdoor facilities are superb with a huge grass playing field and dedicated outdoor learning areas. The KG pool encourages water confidence and early water safety skills. Our children love visiting their library to choose books and meet with their older reading buddies.



# Kindergarten

Our KG children make exceptional progress, and most importantly, have fun whilst engaged in Amazing Learning. The NIS KG curriculum provides challenging and professionally-validated standards with specific learning goals for every area of learning, without losing sight of this unique stage of a child's development.

Our unique approach:

- Develops children to be open-minded, to understand and appreciate their own culture, whilst being open to the perspectives, values and traditions of others
- Encourages personal and independent learning which allows them to explore what they enjoy
- Challenges children with ideas and concepts, encouraging them to ask questions and develop their critical thinking skills

KG children's attainment and progress are regularly evaluated with internal and external benchmark assessments for reading using Raz Plus and math. Learning is constantly evaluated to check progress, and to ensure there are never any lost opportunities for learning we use the Engage and Seesaw e-portfolios.

# Elementary School

The Amazing Learning taking place in the NIS Elementary department provides a solid foundation for our excellent Elementary School teachers to build upon.

## **Our curriculum:**

The AERO Standards promotes an inquiry-based approach to learning, where the rigor of the standards is taught in an integrated way. Subject-specific skills, knowledge and concepts are taught but then they are learnt and applied in meaningful contexts that excite and motivate children to take risks with their learning, and really push themselves to make the best possible progress.



## **Bringing learning to life**

**Our teachers equip learners for life:** At NIS, we connect student learning with the outside world so they can develop a sense of self-worth, an ability to engage with and think critically about the world around them, and to celebrate its diversity.

**Our monitoring and assessment process** enables us to track and monitor student attainment and progress across the school and provides accurate information to parents, in a consistent and accessible way.

**Our teachers believe in the power of reading.** They use a variety of classroom activities and resources to encourage children to explore books through drama, role play and illustration. This encourages the children to think and talk in-depth about the books they read, and to read them intensively, which in turn provides inspiration for their own creative writing, subsequently raising standards.

# Elementary School

**Mathematics in our modern world** is much more than just calculations. At NIS, we ensure our children adopt a flexible approach to problem solving, which is underpinned by a rigorous approach to learning basic skills.

## **We have some of the best learning facilities in Dubai at NIS Elementary:**

- Digital learning through Google for Education program ensures our students are at the cutting-edge of technology with smart 75-inch interactive screens, Chromebooks and iPads for use across the curriculum.
- We have a well-stocked Elementary library, a large multi-purpose gymnasium, an indoor heated swimming pool, and a shaded outdoor auditorium.
- The children also enjoy large age-appropriate outdoor learning and play areas, with a real grass sports field and a garden area to grow their own fruits and vegetables.

# Middle and High School

## High School Program

Our high school has grades 9 through to12 and is designed to prepare students for entrance into the university and program of their choice without having to complete a foundation year. Though our courses are challenging, we still focus on the whole child as we provide student-centered learning experiences that cater to the needs of our students.

Our curriculum is based on the US AERO Standards, as well as other US National Standards (for non-AERO subjects) and UAE National Standards (for Ministry of Education subjects). All courses are of equal importance, as successful completion of each course earns students a half or full credit towards meeting their graduation requirements.

Though the academic year in the country is split into three terms, American-curriculum schools such as NIS run on two semesters (or four quarters). Courses (except Islamic Studies) that bear a half (0.5) credit only last for a semester. Islamic Studies lasts the entire year but will still earn 0.5 credit once successfully completed. Courses that bear a full (1.0) credit last the entire school year (both semesters). Passing a full year course is determined by averaging the first and second semester grade. Successful completion requires a grade of a 60% or higher.

Course grades will be calculated based on the following:

- Ongoing – 70% – This is the grade that will be seen on Google Classroom, but this is NOT the overall grade.
- Midterm – 10% – This exam will be taken at the end of Quarters 1 and 3, which is the middle of each semester.
- Final – 20% – This exam will be taken at the end of Semester 1 and 2.

# Middle and High School

The NIS Middle and High School departments are focused on guiding our students through their academic requirements, while developing lifelong learners that are able to navigate an ever-changing, interdependent global society. Teachers tailor their lessons to students' needs, ensuring that all learning styles and levels are met.

## Amazing Learning opportunities

During the academic school year our students are provided with a range of Amazing Learning opportunities. These activities enable students to enhance their depth of knowledge, to improve themselves as independent individuals, and help them connect their learning to real-life situations.

**Our Middle School** consists of Grades 6 through 8. As these years are a critical period of transition in a student's development, we focus on the whole child as we provide student-centered learning experiences that cater to the needs of our students.

Our curriculum is based on US AERO COMMON CORE Standards as well as other US National Standards (for non-AERO subjects) and UAE National Standards (for Ministry of Education subjects). All courses are of equal importance and treated as such. This does not mean that each course has the same amount of time allocated to it, but we strive to give students a balanced curriculum that allows them to explore and develop their full potential.

**Middle School students** are provided with opportunities to develop their core academics, and are also exposed to arts, music, business, physical education, social studies, as well as French and Arabic. Our teachers provide ongoing support to students as they develop their critical thinking skills with a variety of student-centered instructional methods.

**High School students** are provided with opportunities to experience a variety of courses that appeal to their educational interests. Teachers at the High School level facilitate scholars' learning by exposing them to a variety of educational experiences in and outside the classroom, both within the UAE as well as internationally. Our students are encouraged to try new experiences.



# Middle and High School

## We offer Advanced Placement courses

The College Board developed the Advanced Placement (AP) Program to allow highly motivated students to take university-level courses while still in high school. When taking an AP course, a student could earn university credits based on an AP exam score. This could also lead to avoiding foundation courses at university. Taking an AP course also shows universities that a student is dedicated and able to navigate the academic expectations that will be encountered at university.

The content in each AP course is set by the College Board and cannot be altered, as the information learned will prepare students for the AP exam. The students enrolled in an AP course are expected to take the AP exam, and these are scored on a scale of 1-5. The exam schedule is also set by the College Board, and we cannot make local changes to it. Please understand that an AP exam could be scheduled on a Friday, as the schedule is based on the school week in the United States. **These exams are comprehensive evaluations of the university-level work that has been covered throughout the school year.**

The fee (to be determined) for each exam must be paid to NIS accounts by the specified date that will be determined by the AP Coordinator. Do understand that if a student chooses not to take the College Board exam, 1) s/he will take a final exam in Quarter 4, and the result will be part of the overall grade and 2) the course will be labeled as Honors on the transcript instead of AP. AP teachers may choose to give a midterm assessment in Semester 1, as well as a mock AP exam in Semester 2. The results can be calculated as part of the overall grade.



We encourage all students to challenge themselves through their academic journey. However, because of the increased expectations in an AP course, students must carefully consider their level of commitment before requesting to take any of the offered AP courses. Throughout the school year, AP students will be required to complete assignments, readings, and projects outside of class time. To be admitted, students must fulfill all prerequisites set by the College Board and NIS (based on various data points). In some cases, students might also be asked to seek a teacher recommendation. If the teacher does not recommend a student for the course of choice, a student can take a placement test but must score at least an 90% to enter the course selected.

Considering all of this, please understand that taking an AP course is not mandatory at NIS. We want to be sure that we support students in making the best decisions for their academic future.

# Middle and High School



Due to the rigor of these courses, an additional 0.25 weight will be added to a student's GPA on the transcript. Regardless, if 1) the AP exam is not taken and 2) a student earns a course grade lower than a C- (70%) in an AP course, s/he will not receive the 0.25 weight. For the 2020-2021 school year, NIS is offering the AP courses as follows: English Language and Composition, Calculus AB, Biology, and Chemistry.



## University, Career Guidance and Future Choices

Our well-established career guidance and counseling program develops our students' competence in self-knowledge, education and career planning. Students receive career counseling from Middle School upwards to enable them to make informed choices about their electives according to their chosen career pathway. Our school counselors help all students in the areas of academic achievement, personal development and career development, ensuring our students become productive, well-adjusted adults of tomorrow.

Through our partnerships with the American University in Dubai, University of Balmand and the Canadian University Dubai, we ensure our students are at the forefront of scholarship opportunities in every subject.



# Facilities and Resources

## Wonderful School Facilities

Situated alongside the Green Community in Dubai Investment Park, our students have access to some of the best school facilities in Dubai, with vast green outdoor learning and play areas, including:

- a large floodlit sports field with natural grass;
- a large multipurpose gymnasium and tennis court;
- Science laboratories;
- a temperature controlled swimming pool;
- a training pool for KG children;
- a specialist art and music room;
- a shaded auditorium and performance studio;
- two well-stocked libraries.

## Information and Communications Technology (ICT) at NIS

Committed to a progressive digital learning platform, we are continually investing in new technology to enhance our teaching and learning. We ensure that students use cutting-edge technology to enhance their learning. Some of these include:

- multimedia facilities;
- 3D printing equipment;
- 75-inch interactive smart screens;
- Chromebooks and iPads for classroom use;

As a proud Google for Education school, we receive updated support and resources to develop digital readiness programs for our students. This helps to prepare them with the skill set they need to thrive in the future. NIS is one of the few Google for Education schools in Dubai.



# Facilities and Resources

## Medical Care

In accordance with the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health regulations, NIS has a well-equipped medical clinic with a full-time trained and experienced nurse and a DHA licensed medical doctor, who is a highly experienced pediatrician.

## School Cafeteria

At NIS we believe in healthy lifestyle choices and this includes providing healthy food options in our cafeteria. We have partnered with Accuro to provide our students with the Accuro Kids Menu.

# Beyond the classroom

## Extra-Curricular Activities (ECAs)

There are many benefits for students who engage in a broad range of extracurricular activities. This exposure allows them to experience new opportunities, develop new talents, enhance their social skills and support their academic progress. The activities offered at NIS are always growing and developing. They include, but are not limited to:

### Sports

NIS has partnered with 'Just Play', one of the leading sports management companies in the UAE working with a large network of public and private schools. They are our partner in delivering Extra-Curricular Activities, Holiday Camps to our students, and they also manage our sports facilities.

Just Play works with over 30 different sports/non-sports providers who all have specialist teachers and qualified coaches delivering a wide range of activities. As 'Just Play' is an approved establishment under the Dubai Sports Council, they follow all the imposed safety guidelines.

### Counseling

Our students have access to high quality emotional support via our dedicated, highly qualified and experienced counseling team. These dedicated counselors ensure every student has a trained adult to talk to and has the ability to address their individual needs and anxieties. Support is provided in social, emotional and learning aspects of life at school. All students receive university entrance and careers counseling, including face-to-face time with numerous universities. Students regularly comment on the quality of support provided which adds to their well-being. Our counselors ensure every child's needs are fully met through a dedicated program of additional language learning, career and counseling support.



# Beyond the classroom

## Student Support Team (SST)

The Student Support Team is a proactive problem-solving approach to supporting students who are falling behind academically. The team determines the level of support a child needs or whether or not the child is eligible to receive special education services. The purpose is to design a support system aligned to the student's specific area of need, so that we can increase the success of the student in the curriculum and within the classroom.

## Support for Students of Determination

The Inclusion Department provides support for children of determination (additional learning needs). Team members ensure that the academic, social, emotional and behavioral needs of all our children are being met.

## English as an Additional Language (EAL)

At NIS, English Language Learners (ELLs) are assessed by using the IDEA Online IPT English Proficiency Test which gives the accurate English proficiency level of a student. If their English language status is at beginner or early developing levels, pull-out interventions are arranged, which include one-on-one support in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. These domains include English language skills and English literacy development.

English Language Development (ELD) and Sheltered Instruction (SI) are the two main models in the EAL program focusing on the following:

- **Phonology:** the sound system of English
- **Morphology:** the forms and formation of words
- **Syntax:** the rules and structure of the English language
- **Semantics:** the meaning of language, including vocabulary and academic language
- **Language functions:** the purposes of language use

**Pragmatics:** the appropriate use of the English language in various contexts

## NIS provides specialist support to students in various ways:

- A variety of assessment methods to monitor performance and progress.
- Individualized Education Plans (IEP) that specify the structure of support, category of eligibility, child's areas of need and strength, interventions, and goals.
- Specialized in-class support and modifications that are tailored to the child's individual needs.
- Tiered levels of support based on the child's response to interventions.
- Regular communication between parents, teachers and specialist teachers.



# Beyond the classroom

## Model United Nations at NIS (NISMUN)

Open to Grades 8 and above, NISMUN is a school team with a rigorous selection process. Academic excellence in all classes is a requirement, alongside attendance at meetings twice a week and enrollment in International Relations (Social Studies elective). Selected NISMUN students will attend conferences in the UAE and abroad.

## (Virtual) Buddy Exchange Program

The ISP Buddy Exchange Program enables reciprocal exchanges between ISP schools for one month for students between 14 – 17 years of age. It is an experience that promises to offer students amazing and diverse learning opportunities within a safe and secure environment.

The program will deliver a unique international and cultural learning experience; enabling students to develop their language skills, share good practice, and cultivate long-term friendships across the world.

## Student Council

A group of students from different grades is elected by peers to address issues, organize events and activities, as well as advocate for their peers. It allows students to demonstrate their creativity, develop critical thinking and team-building skills, explore their passions and work on their individual leadership styles.

## NYUAD Institute Lecture Series

Attending a university lecture series can be an eye-opening experience for our scholars. The NYU Abu Dhabi Institute brings people together to experience new ideas and discuss pressing global issues.

## Educational Visits

Students from KG to Grade 5 participate in visits which include historical, scientific and adventure activities to enrich the curriculum and support amazing learning.

## International Travel

Students participate in targeted international travel opportunities to showcase their talents and experiences in their areas of interest. Some of the past initiatives were Elementary Residential (Dibba, UAE, March 2019), ISP MUN trip to Spain, Senior Service Expedition to Cyprus, and Outward Bound Excursions (Oman Spring 2020).



# FAQ's

## The School Day

The school gates open at 7:30am. All students are expected to be settled in class by 7:45am. The school day ends for KG at 1:00pm, and for Elementary, Middle and High at 2:45pm.

## Transportation

## Uniform

All students are required to wear the school uniform and sports kit. This is not included in the tuition fees. You can purchase the uniform from our partner Trutex, who has a shop on the school campus.

## Educational resources (online) and textbooks

NIS uses textbooks during the learning journey. Textbooks can be purchased from the book shop which is located on the school campus. Textbooks are not included in the school fees.

Our school uses various online resources and educational tools, so our students have access to the content when it is suitable for them. NIS uses the classroom app Seesaw for students from KG1 to G3 and Google Classroom for higher grades. Starting in Fall 2019/2020 Academic Year, students (Grade 3 - 12) will be required to bring a Chromebook, or their own device to school.

## Campus and Facilities

International Schools Partnership (ISP) have invested significantly in the premises since 2018 and many of the facilities have been upgraded. NIS has a large real-grass field including a floodlit full-size football pitch, a KG swimming pool, a refurbished heated swimming pool with a full-time lifeguard, a multi-purpose gymnasium, a music room, an art room, a drama room, a covered amphitheater, an Elementary and a Secondary library (both with latest interactive boards), science labs, and a renovated cafeteria.
